Bad formation rule in MISSION\_START/STOP\_DATE description      SCR3-1117.v1

## Problem:

The MISSION\_START/STOP\_DATE keywords have a general data type of DATE, which implies a formation like YYYY-MM-DD - specifically, without a time component. The DESCRIPTIONs for these keywords, however, both contain this line:

Formation rule: YYYY-MM-DDThh:mm:ss[.fff]

## Priority:

Medium. This appears to be a minor cut-and-paste error that should be easily corrected at the next PSDD database update.

## Proposed Solution:

Change the problematic line to:

Formation rule: YYYY-MM-DD

## Impact Assessment:

- The PSDD database will require an update.

**Recommended Actions:**
