- Slide 5: Eva notes it is still hard to map the SRD level requirements to the user stories that are in the RDD.
- Slide 7: Scott notes that the pds-int machine is running Linux 3.10.0 which he thinks is based on RHEL 7 which NASA want to have NASA machines move off of in 2022. Jordan states they may upgrade pds-int prior to test.
- Slide 14: Scott believe the test team does have some pad before their early December release.
- Slide 18: Scott asks that the team assign criticality to the remaining "unknown" criticality bugs prior to the PDS 12.0 DDR.
- Eva asks if they are doing any code coverage for their testing. JPL SDR does require coverage metrics. Jordan answers that with there recent move to DevOps they are looking at how to add code coverage.
