As a side note, there were some on the CCB who felt that items 280 and 279 were not changes to the IM and therefore did not require a CCB vote, but votes were gathered rather than debate the issue. As was done here, the DDWG should continue to push items to the CCB for a vote unless the SCR can be clearly defined and documented as a bug fix or an update to the documentation that does not change the standard. Items not requiring a vote should still be referred to the CCB for concurrence.
