CCB-260, the proposal to introduce a new file extension for PDS4 labels, has just passed DDWG vote 9 to 1 (radio science voted no, all others voted yes):

Note that this ticket allows .lblx to be used (but not mixed with .xml in a single collection), but does not specify when this would become mandatory, as this is shunted to CCB-338.

I understand this went through extensive discussions at DDWG level, but the final outcome looks pretty clean and straightforward. Nevertheless, if anyone needs to discuss this, please let me know by Friday so that we could hold a telecon on Tuesday 16th, otherwise let's try an e-vote by Wednesday 17th.
